Since the introduction of the improved System of Bee Culture, many efforts have been made to take advantage of these facts in producing non-swarming hives, but all of them being based on erroneous conceptions of the causes producing these results, they have been failures. The addition to hives of extensive box room on the top, it was soon found, would not do it. The addition of boxes on the side, while it produced better results, failed to prevent swarming. The introduction of the Melextractor caused many bee-keepers to do away with boxes, and instead give additional room in the hive for frames, without separating them...
